-full name of all author in upper and lower case

-leave 2 spaces before starting on the text abstract. Text of abstract should start with objective of the study followed by methodology, result and conclusion.

-text abstract should not exceed 200 words

-the text should be in Arial, font 11 and a single spacing

-format: Microsoft word 2003

Only certain number of abstract will be chosen for oral presentations and the remaining will be subjected for poster presentation. Acceptance of the free papers will be announced via email.

Prizes will be awarded for the best 3 free paper presented. Abstract will not be accepted without payment of registration fees.
