More FMS selected for Haj Medical Team 2019

For the first time, the largest number of FMS were selected to join the Haj Medical Team in Saudi Arabia this year. This is to conform with the Saudi regulation that requires 20% of the medical team should comprises of preventive medical practitioner. A total of nine FMS will depart to Saudi starting end of

June. They will fill up different position while in Mecca and Madinah. Dr Abd Jalil will hold the Mecca Operational Director position, while the rest will fill up the FMS and medical officer post. They will remain in Saudi for at least two months until the end of Haj session in August. Best wishes and good luck to all of them.

FMSA Study Tour Grant : VISIT TO ELDERLY NURSING HOME IN YAMAGATA, JAPAN- A WINDOW OF EXPERIENCE

A group of FMS Selangor visited Higashi Zawa Roujin Home in the Provincial District of Murayama, Yamagata, Japan on 4th April 2018. The group consisted of five FMSes and one translator. The goal of the visit is to learn from Japan on how they support the elderly in this nursing homes and formal aged care. The home is a private organization. There were a total of 90 elderly residents, aged from 70 to 103 years old. Care manager (CM) is a key figure in the organization acting as a



liaison between the hospital, the local council and the home. CM organizes, plans and assists the elderly to receive the best possible care that they could get to ensure continuity of care. The home service provides short term and long term care services involving multidisciplinary approach by visiting geriatrician, nurses, occupational therapist, physiotherapist, nutritionist and trained personnel. The visit was immensely beneficial and was an excellent opportunity to experience the secret of longevity among Japanese elderly especially in the aged care.

"Kesihatan Si Manja: Apakah Peranan Anda?" by Penang


